
'PINO' SPECIAL NATURAL WINE **PINOT NOIR + PINE TIPS**

Redacted Vineyard, Tualatin Hills AVA Willamette Valley, Oregon, U.S.A

QUICK SUMMARY:

The etymology of Pinot Noir is the pine cone. So, for me, a connection had already been established. It just took some bold creativity to imagine them together somehow. As a tough critic of my own wines and Willamette Valley Pinot Noir in general, I was not happy with how my 2019 Pinot Noir was tasting that Spring of 2020. Time to get creative. Time to think outside the box. Those memories of pine tips came to mind and a new wine was born.

We harvested pine tips from around the vineyard and added them into our barrels in small increments that whole year. Once the desired taste was achieved, the wine was again left to rest. In total, the wine spent 28 months in barrels, gaining compaction, depth, and a singular expression of Pinot Noir from our pine covered hill behind Forest Grove
