QUICK SUMMARY:

The Baroque style is characterized by exaggerated motion and clear detail used to produce drama, exuberance, and grandeur in sculpture, painting, architecture, literature, dance, and music. Baroque iconography was direct, obvious, and dramatic, intending to appeal above all, to one's senses and emotions. We've extended this art form into the vinous world. Like a painter using multiple colors, this co-fermentation of numerous traditional Italian grapes allowed us to make something singular and profound. This wine was conceived in a single vineyard in the Columbia Gorge by an artist with an eye towards enlightenment. Our 'Baroque' was made to elevate what it means to be an Oregon wine. Bottled unfiltered (Vegan) and unfiltered.
